\$65 million secured for the extension of Stephenson Avenue

I am extremely pleased to announce \$65 million has been secured in this month's Federal Budget for the extension of Stephenson Avenue. I have been campaigning tirelessly on behalf of the City of Stirling to see their vision for the Stirling City Centre realised. With this funding, that is now possible.

This project will see the first stage of the Stirling City Centre delivered by extending Stephenson Avenue through to the Mitchell Freeway, providing a wider connection into the Osborne Park and Herdsman/Glendalough area. It will not only help ease traffic congestion, but also open up large areas of land for new commercial development which will strengthen our local economy and small business hub, and create local jobs.

With a surge in residential and commercial development in our local area over the past few years it is vital that we fund future urban infrastructure and transport projects that best support the needs of our growing community.

I congratulate the City of Stirling for their persistence and dedication to see this funding delivered, and look forward to the many opportunities it will provide for Stirling residents and businesses.

A message from Michael

Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull visited Perth in April to announce a massive \$3.2 billion infrastructure package for Western Australia, securing investment in vital road and hospital upgrades for Stirling.

Welcome to Osborne Park Hospital

\$10.6 million for the Osborne Park Hospital Extension

Osborne Park Hospital will be upgraded thanks to a \$10.6 million funding commitment from the Turnbull Government. This funding will support the WA State Government to upgrade the neonatal facility and provide additional rehabilitation beds for residents.

The Turnbull Government is investing \$188.9 million in WA hospital infrastructure which includes Osborne Park Hospital. The additional investment also supports:

- ✓ \$158 million towards the Joondalup Health Campus Expansion which will include 90 new public beds, 75 new mental health beds, a new stroke unit, 3 new cardiac catheter laboratories, new 25 bed Coronary Care Unit, an urgent care clinic, an ambulatory care centre, and a Medihotel facility; and
- ✓ \$20.3 million for the refurbishment of the Royal Perth Hospital including the mental health observation unit and Medihotel.

Investing in WA hospital care is important, and the Turnbull Government is committed to supporting Stirling residents and families who need it most.

\$500 million for the construction of the Morley-Ellenbrook line

The Turnbull Government has committed \$500 million to construct the Morley – Ellenbrook line under METRONET. This is fantastic news for Stirling residents, especially those living in Morley and Dianella who will have greater transport options getting into the City and surrounding areas.

Other METRONET projects funded under the Federal Government include:

- ✓ \$241 million for the extension of the **Armadale Line to Byford**;
- ✓ \$83 million for the **Midland Station Project**, including the relocation of Midland Station;
- ✓ \$2 million for a **railway station at Lakelands**; and
- ✓ \$226 million to support **other METRONET related projects**.

\$32 million to **widen the Mitchell Freeway Southbound from Cedric Street to Vincent Street**

- \$145 million for the **Tonkin Highway Gap project**
- \$183 million for the **Hale, Welshpool and Kelvin interchanges**

\$108 million for the **Mitchell Freeway extension from Hester Avenue to Romeo Road**

\$47 million for the **Welshpool Road interchange at Leach Highway**
